In this meeting, we mainly focus on correcting the error.</p> <p>Through investigation, we found the join query was the main reason caused the error. We found that same awb may exist in the consecutive month in the case that if the awb couldn't be closed in this month, it will drag to next month, so the same awb will exist. In our previous data cleaning, we remove the duplicate the record which leads to the column raw_expected_day does not capture the latest date, which then affect the derived column checkSCVSEDDNC.</p> <p>We came out with a solution which is joining awb+shipperaccount, but the results were incorrect. We also tried adding a subquery in Power BI and adding relationship for two queries, but it failed because Power BI was unable to find relationship between tables.</p> <p>Finally, we decided to move on to next task. We will further discuss this problems with Viviane in the next meeting.</p>
