Registration of the students, filter by classes? Allowing facilitator to create a tournament within the class? Can facilitator assign control of the duration of the tournament?</p> <p>Tracking students by events (could be a final exam at the end of the term) RP: Limit students to complete certain questions C: Best not to limit students. RP: Requests to see how many levels are completed out of total number of levels on events page – would like to track each of the topics and see which are the topics students are weak in RP: Could Force students to register for events when the register on website</p> <p>Events Introduction C: create a short tutorial video under the Events page how to use this feature (Note to Genshyft) If 1000 students appear under the events, perhaps have a checkbox beside the names and have a checkbox that says “Select All” under the RSVP section Filter the students by classes (have that data field) – C: not a good idea, could be enforcing authority RP: Need to enforce it since students wouldn't sign up if this was optional. Facilitator can see the students on the list C: Will report data by event to RP Include a link that will bring them to the Event page. Bring them to a page that includes the events AND the ranking</p>
